




FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ECS0118BK ENGINE CASE SLIDERS
SUZUKI GSX-R1000 '17- (RIGHT HAND SIDE ONLY)

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


LEGEND

- ITEM 1 = ENGINE CASE SLIDER (ECS0118) (x1).
- ITEM 2 = COMP SLEEVE (*PRE-FITTED*) (CS503) (x1).
- ITEM 3 = COMP SLEEVE (*PRE-FITTED*) (CS473) (x1).
- ITEM 4 = COMP SLEEVE (*PRE-FITTED*) (CS504) (x1).
- ITEM 5 = M6 x 35mm LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x1).
- ITEM 6 = M6 x 50mm LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x1).
- ITEM 7 = M6 x 45mm LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x1).
- ITEM 8 = M6 WASHERS (3).

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 4, 5mm A/F socket & wrench.
 - 8mm spanner or socket & wrench.
 - Flat head screwdriver.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Right side (as you sit on bike)

- To fit the Engine Case Slider, the right side fairing must first be removed from the motorcycle.
- Remove the under-nose plastic cowling, by removing the six push rivets arrowed in pictures 1 & 2 and the remaining two push rivets in the centre, as shown in picture 3.
- To remove the right side fairing, remove the four bolts that are arrowed in pictures 4 & 5 and the push rivet that mounts the radiator cowling that is shown in picture 6.
- The right side fairing can now be removed from the bike. Start by pulling the rear off its rubber mount, as shown in picture 7, before removing the top edge from its rubber mount and plastic locating tabs, as shown in picture 8. With the top edge released, disconnect the wiring connector for the indicator, as shown in picture 9 then unclip the mounts along the front bottom edge that mount the bellypan to the radiator surround. The fairing should then be free to be removed from the bike.
- Remove the three M6 bolts as positioned where the slider fits, as shown in picture 10.
- Insert the new button head bolts with washers through the slider as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Offer up to bike.
- Tighten evenly to manufactures specified torque.
- Fit bubble sticker as shown above.
- Re-fit the fairing in the reverse procedure of removal, ensuring that the indicator connector is re-connected.

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





NOTICE DE MONTAGE

Coté droit (assis sur la moto)

- Pour monter le slider de carter moteur, le carénage du coté droit doit être enlevé de la moto.
- Retirer le capot plastique sous le nez, en enlevant les 6 rivets, voir photos 1 & 2 et les 2 rivets restants dans le centre, voir photo 3.
- Pour enlever le carénage du coté droit, enlever les 4 boulons indiqués sur les photos 4 & 5 et le rivet qui fixe le capot de radiateur, indiqué sur la photo 6.
- Le carénage du coté droit peut maintenant être enlevé de la moto. Commencer par tirer l'arrière de son support de fixation, voir photo 7, avant d'enlever le bord supérieur et les onglets de fixation, voir photo 8. Une fois le bord supérieur libéré, déconnecter le connecteur de câbles de clignotant, voir photo 9 puis déclipser les supports avec le bord inférieur avant qui fixent le carénage au contour de radiateur. Le carénage doit ensuite pouvoir être libéré de la moto.
- Enlever les 3 boulons M6 indiqués à l'endroit où le slider se positionne, voir photo 10.
- Insérer les nouveaux boulons avec rondelles dans le slider, voir le schéma.
- Montez le sur la moto.
- Serrer aux couples de serrage.
- Insérer un sticker en caoutchouc, comme ci-dessus.
- Remonter le carénage en procédant à l'inverse du démontage, en veillant à ce que le connecteur de clignotant soit reconnecté.

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
