



ITEM $2 = M6 \times 45 \text{mm}$ LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x1).

ITEM $3 = M6 \times 50 \text{mm}$ LONG BUTTON HEAD BOLTS (x1).

ITEM 4 = M6 WASHERS (3x).

ITEM 5 = ENGINE CASE SLIDER (ECS0119) (x1).


ITEM 6 = COMP SLEEVE (PRE-FITTED) (CS511) (x1).

ITEM 7 = COMP SLEEVE (PRE-FITTED) (CS512) (x1).

ITEM 8 = COMP SLEEVE (PRE-FITTED) (CS513) (x1).

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 4, 5mm A/F socket & wrench.
 - 8mm spanner or socket & wrench.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Left side (as you sit on bike)

- Remove the four bolts that secure the belly pan in place (as arrowed in picture 1) and remove the
- Remove the three M6 bolts as positioned where the slider fits, as shown in picture 2.
- Locate the slider (Item 5) in position.
- Insert the new cap head (Item 1) with one washer (Item 4) through the top mounting point as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Insert the shorter button head bolt (Item 2) with one washer (item 4) through the mid mounting point as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Insert the shorter button head bolt (Item 3) with one washer (item 4) through the bottom mounting point as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Tighten evenly to manufactures specified torque.
- Place the bubble sticker in the allocated profile in the slider (as shown in picture 3).
- Re-fit the belly pan as original.

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

ARTICLE 5 = SLIDER CARTER MOTEUR (ECS0119) (x1). ARTICLE $6 = \text{MANCHON } (PR\acute{E} - MONT\acute{E})$ (CS511) (x1).

ARTICLE 7 = MANCHON (PRÉ-MONTÉ) (CS512) (x1).

ARTICLE 8 = MANCHON (PRÉ-MONTÉ) (CS513) (x1).

- Clé à cliquet + douille 4, 5mm
 - Clé à molette 8mm



NOTICE DE MONTAGE:

Côté gauche (lorsqu'on est assis sur la moto)

- Enlever les 4 boulons qui fixent le ventre en place (voir photo 1) puis enlevez le ventre de carénage.
- Enlever les 3 boulons M6 à l'endroit où le slider se positionne, voir photo 2.
- Placer le slider (Article 5) en position.
- Insérer le nouveau boulon (Article 1) avec une rondelle (Article 4) dans le point de fixation supérieur, voir le schéma.
- Insérer le boulon plus courts (Article 2) avec une rondelle (article 4) dans le point de fixation intermédiaire visible sur le schéma.
- Insérer le boulon le plus court (Article 3) avec une rondelle (article 4) dans le point de fixation du bas, voir le schéma.
- Serrer selon les valeurs de serrage recommandées.
- Placer le sticker en caoutchouc dans le profil correspondant du slider (voir photo 3).
- Remonter le ventre de carénage comme à l'origine.

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
