

## FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR R&G LICENCE PLATE HANGER

## HONDA CBR600 RR '07 Onwards (part code LP0042BK)



- Remove both seats.
- Remove rear seat cowling.
- Disconnect wiring to original number plate unit.
- Undo the four bolts holding the original number plate unit to the subframe.
- Remove OEM indicators and rear light unit from original number plate unit.
- The OEM tail unit should be in three parts ie; two sides and one number plate hanger.
- Replace both side assemblies to sub-frame using supplied button head screws and washers (note 4 longest screws and larger washers to be used) but leave all screws loose.
- Fit OEM or after-market indicators (we recommend R&G micro indicators product code RG370) to OEM sides
- If not already assembled, assemble new light unit to tail-tidy routing wires through the pre drilled hole.
- Offer new tail-tidy unit up between side panels.
- Using shorter button head screws and smaller washers supplied secure new tail-tidy to OEM sides using
  nyloc nuts supplied.
- Route indicator and new rear light wiring through clips provided as original.
- Reconnect indicator wires, checking operation (Note: right side indicator has the ORANGE connector).
- Using scotch block connectors supplied, re-attach the rear light wiring (suggest cutting connector from OEM unit and splicing to R&G unit).

New wires		OEM wires
Black	to	Black
Yellow	to	Black/White
Red	to	Black/Yellow

- IMPORTANT: IF FITTING A FULL-SIZE LICENCE PLATE AND PLACING IT FAR DOWN ON THE LICENCE PLATE HANGER, THERE IS A SMALL CHANCE OF THE LICENCE PLATE HITTING THE BACK WHEEL UNDER HEAVY LOAD AND OVER LARGE BUMPS IN THE ROAD. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK FOR THIS POSSIBILITY AND TAKE AVOIDING ACTION. FAILURE TO CHECK THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
- Recheck that wires are not touching exhaust silencer.
- Tighten screws securing tail-tidy to sub-frame.
- Refit rear cowling.
- Refit seats.
- Depending on local laws, attach enclosed red reflective tape in an appropriate location.
- Test the indicators and licence plate illuminator before riding.

These terms do not affect the Buyer's statutory rights.

## **R&G RACING RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)**

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected). Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor. Goods must be in resellable condition, in the opinion of R&G Racing. All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase). The customer must pay any and all carriage charges. No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase. This policy does not affect your statutory rights and does not refer to faulty goods.
